All degree holders of The National University of Advanced Legal Studies (NUALS) from its very first batch can access their degree certificates through DigiLocker. B.A.LL.B., LL.M. and Ph.D. students will get this facility.


DigiLocker was implemented with the assistance of the national e-governance division and the state IT Mission.

With this, NUALS becomes the first university in Kerala and the first law university in India to be fully digital in issuing certificates, the university claimed. Students can access the NAD link given on the website of NUALS and register for accessing the certificates. Digital Certificates are treated equally at par with original certificates.

The step-by-step instruction for accessing the NAD is as follows.




Step 5.

Once you login the home page as shown will be displayed.




Step 6.
